Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

One of the blessings of living in this great country of ours is that we have a tremendous legacy of faith, beginning with the very founders of our nation. Even today, we can look to them for insight and wisdom in spiritual matters.

Take, for example, the Puritans. Today, we think of them as the people with the black and white clothes, funny shaped guns, and celebrating the first Thanksgiving with their newfound Indian friends. The truth, however, is a little deeper. They laid the foundations not only for our Constitution, but for Congregational churches across America. And they had keen insight into the human spirit. They had a saying, *"the same sun that melts the ice hardens the clay."* 

Remember the Bible story about Moses and Pharaoh? Time and time again, Moses would come into the presence of Pharaoh, announcing yet another destructive plague because the Israelites had not yet been released. And time and time again, Pharaoh did not release them. In fact, he seemed to dig his heels in deeper, resolving not to.

And the Bible says that Pharaoh's heart was hard. Sometimes he hardened it, sometimes it just says that it was hard, and sometimes God hardened it.

Moses, on the other hand, reacted differently. When Moses first encountered God during a conversation with a burning bush, he was pretty resistant. Moses came up with a couple excuses to not do what God had in mind, which God dealt with one by one. When Moses couldn't come up with any more excuses, he begged God, "O my Lord, please send someone else."

But Moses went. He allowed the ice to melt. He obeyed, and over the course of the next several decades, Moses developed an increasingly close relationship with God.

That's what the Puritans were talking about. God prompts and directs us, but the key is how we react. Sometimes we do what we're supposed to, and sometimes we don't. Moses eventually did what God wanted him to do. Pharoah did not. David could have hardened his heart, but didn't. Jonah hardened his heart, then didn't. Jonah hardened his heart, then didn't, then did. And what would have happened if Paul refused to turn from his former life of persecuting Christians instead of planting churches?

Is your heart hard? If we're honest, we have to say sometimes. We all have times when we want to do what we want to do, and don't let God tell us otherwise. When God tells us to do something, we become like Pharoah and say 'No!' When God says no, we say 'I want to anyway.' That's what Pharaoh did, and we do too! In fact, pretty much **every time we sin**, it can be directly attributed to our hard hearts!

The point is, don't let your heart get hard. When God tells you the truth, let your heart melt in the warmth instead of bake in the sun.


