Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Luke 13:5 "But unless you repent, you too will all perish."

Have you ever put a sweater in a washing machine? If so, you know you have to be careful. Lots of times, you aren't supposed to do that. They must be dry cleaned or they get completely ruined. But even with the ones that don't demand to be dry cleaned, you must proceed with caution. And even when you follow the instructions and do everything the way you are supposed to, you are still guaranteed that the sweater you pull out of the machine will be stretched out and heavy from the water. But you can't put it in the dryer! No, you have to gently push it back into shape and let it dry in the air.

Lent is a little bit like that. It's a time for getting bent back into shape. Much like a sweater, we all come through the washing machine of life a little heavy-hearted, a little stretched out, and at times, a little traumatized. The good news is that God takes great care in bending us back into shape. One way, perhaps *the* way, he does so is through repentance. Lent is a special time in which Christians take time to remember the importance of repenting.

Repentance is more than feeling sorry for sin. It involves deep sorrow and regret, of course, but it also involves concrete action. It involves a decision to walk away from habits and attitudes, and it involves taking steps to make sure the sin in question stops or never happens again.

Are you bent out of shape? We all are! Allow God to bend you back.

Prayer: Gentle and forgiving God, grant that your Holy Spirit would show me the ways in which I am bent, and through your Spirit, lead me to repentance, that I might be restored to the way you created me to be. In Christ's name, amen.
